

ENCLOS DE VIAUD

LALANDE-DE-POMEROL



Lalande-de-Pomerol is located on a splendid gravel hill. L'Enclos de Viaud is just on the other side of "La Barbanne" lieu-dit Viaud and Maréchaude. The property counts 3.18 hectares spread on 2 parcels.

In 2012, Peter Kwok acquired the Château La Patache and Enclos de Viaud in partnership with his son Howard.

Both crus are separated by « la Barbanne », a small stream that separates Pomerol and Lalande de Pomerol.

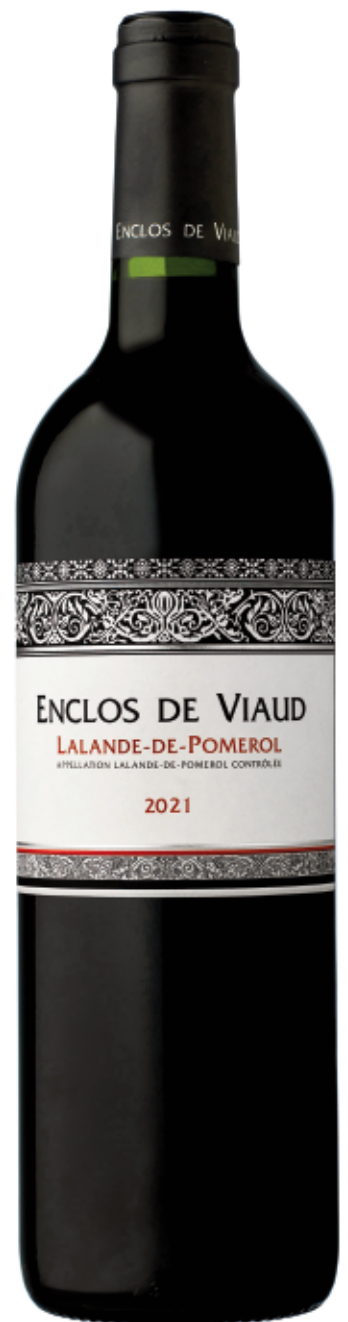
Primarily planted with Merlot, parcel management of the soils and vineyards is applied.

TASTING

Aromas of redcurrants and plums, combined with hints of herbs. Supple on the palate, with precise, silky, very fresh tannins and well-integrated acidity.

ENCLOS DE VIAUD 2021 - FACTS

SURFACE	3.18 hectares
BLEND	85% Merlot - 15 % Cabernet Franc
SOILS	Clay and fine Gravel
HARVEST DATES	5th October
VINIFICATION	After hand-picking with plastic crates and a first selection of the grapes in the vineyard, these arrive in the winery where they are destalked and carefully sorted once more. The grapes are then casked in stainless steel tanks for vinification.
AGEING	10% new barrels, 90% 1-wine barrels
PRODUCTION	7 000 bottles

JAMES SUCKLING - 90

Tapenade, black bean puree and spiced plums. Fluid and medium-bodied on the palate with fine-grained tannins and a supple, juicy finish. A lighter wine but composed and well-balanced. Drink now. *James Suckling February 2022*

YVES BECK - 89

D'entrée Enclos de Viaud se positionne avec finesse et subtilité. Les nuances florales et fruitées du bouquet annoncent un vin agréable, ce qui est bien relayé par la mise en bouche.
